

New UCLA Treatment Study for Children with Autism

The purpose of this 3-month study is to examine the combined effects of medication and a behavioral intervention on language development in children with autism.

Children are eligible to participate if they

- ♦ Are between 5-11 years of age
- ♦ Have an autism spectrum disorder (ASD)
- ♦ Have low language ability

Participants will receive

- ♦ Language intervention
- ♦ Aripiprazole or placebo (inactive medication)
- ♦ Questionnaires, interviews, psychological and laboratory testing
- ♦ Up to \$320
