

New UCLA Treatment Study for Children with Autism

The purpose of this 3-month study is to examine the combined effects of medication and a behavioral intervention on language development in children with autism.

Children are eligible to participate if they

- ◆ Are between 5-11 years of age
- ◆ Have an autism spectrum disorder (ASD)
- ◆ Have low language ability

Participants will receive

- ◆ Language intervention
- ◆ Aripiprazole or placebo (inactive medication)
- ◆ Questionnaires, interviews, psychological and laboratory testing
- ◆ Up to \$320
