SCHOOL PROGRAM

Bridgeport School educates students with mild cognitive delays and challenges in the areas of social communication and/or language development. It is designed for students, ages five to twenty-one, who benefit from intensive academic remediation in core subject areas combined with community-based instruction and vocational services

The mission of Bridgeport School is to provide our students with the ability to access skills that will improve their quality of life, and to assist them in becoming productive members of their communities.

This integrated educational and therapeutic program, located in Sherman Oaks, is designed to promote academic communicative, behavioral, social, motor, adaptive and independent living skills. The curriculum is based on a multidisciplinary team approach that includes the following:

- Appropriate Social Interactions
- Reading, Decoding and Comprehension
- Meaningful Reading – labels, directions, newspapers, applications
- Math Computation
- Money Recognition and money management
- Time and time management
- Language Arts
- Community-Based Instruction

- Pre-requisite and requisite consumer skills
- Pre-vocational and vocational skills
- Education related services such as speech and language therapy counseling, adaptive physical education, and occupational therapy.

CAMPUSES

Bridgeport School is located in Sherman Oaks on a five-acre state-of-the-art educational complex. The campus includes a daily living center, sensory training center, computer-learning center, athletic and play areas and a student-operated store.

CERTIFICATION

Bridgeport School is a member agency of The Help Group and is fully certified by the California Department of Education.
