

UCLA Seeks to Detect Autism Earlier in Life

Do you want to help?

**If you have a family history of autism,
you may be eligible to participate
in a study of infant development at UCLA**

Infants with no family history of autism may also be eligible as a comparison group

Participating families will receive:

- ◆ **\$30-50 for each visit to UCLA**
- ◆ **Developmental feedback**
- ◆ **A picture of your baby's brain**
- ◆ **Free intervention if eligible**



Eligible infants are under six weeks old and have either:

- ◆ *More than one sibling with autism,*
- ◆ *One sibling with autism and an extended family history of the disorder, or*
- ◆ *No family history of autism or other developmental disorders*

Participation is free | Medical insurance not required



Visits to UCLA during your baby's first year will include:

- ◆ **Developmental Assessments**
- ◆ **Eye-Tracking**
- ◆ **Non-Invasive EEG**
- ◆ **MRI** (no sedation or radiation involved)
