## Individualized/Differentiated Instruction

In addition to a rigorus academic curiculum, we offer enrichment classes including visual arts, graphic design, 3D modeling in robotics, ceramics, and music foundations.

## College Prep

Students matriculate to four-year universities, community colleges, and trade schools and receive support in college and career planning through an integrated counseling program, including workshops and one-on-one sessions.

## **Interventions & Services**

Intensive reading intervention targets specific skills in reading classes and is integrated into the overall curriculum to ensure ample opportunities for practice and mastery. Our math lab helps fill in gaps to support our students in their grade-level math classes. Supportive services tailored to each student's individualized needs are also provided.

One in five students identified as having a learning difference will walk away from their education; the appropriate learning environment is critical to their success. At Summit View, intensive, individualized research-based strategies are delivered through an interactive, hands-on, multisensory approach. A rich extracurricular program such as sports, special interest clubs, student council, as well as counseling, speech and language and occupational therapy complement the curriculum. Class sizes are small with high student to teacher ratios. Summit View has much to offer motivated, creative. and athletic students!
