### AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER

**Grades: K - 12th**

A college preparatory program for students with social communication, language, and/or socialization delays, including autism.

**Bridgeport**  
**Grades: K - 12th**

Academic remediation, life skills instruction, and behavioral support for children and young adults with mild cognitive delays and social communication challenges.

**Bridgeport Vocational Center**  
**Transition**  
*Sherman Oaks / Culver City*

Career education and practical skills application for students 18 to 22 years old.

**Sunrise**  
**Grades: K - 12th & Transition**  
*Sherman Oaks / Culver City*

Functional life skills instruction programs serving students with moderate to severe developmental delays including autism and related disorders.

### LEARNING DIFFERENCES/ADHD

**Summit View**  
**Grades: K - 12th**  
*Valley Glen / Culver City*

A comprehensive college preparatory program addressing the needs of students with learning differences and/or ADHD.

### THRICE EXCEPTIONAL

**STEM<sup>3</sup> Academy**  
**Grades: K - 12th**

For academically strong students with social and/or learning differences, including autism, who have a passion for STEM subjects (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics).

### SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL CHALLENGES

Differentiated college preparatory academic instruction paired with intensive therapeutic and behavioral services for students with social and emotional challenges, including depression and anxiety.

**Westview**  
**Grades: 6 - 12th**

An inclusive, therapeutic, and differentiated college preparatory program for students with social and emotional challenges, including depression and anxiety.

# SUPPORT PROGRAMS

## RESIDENTIAL

### Project Six

Educationally-related residential treatment program providing intense therapeutic and rehabilitation services to support students in returning to their families and schools of residence

### Project Six Adult Residential Program

Provides community-based group homes for adults with developmental disabilities, and is committed to a person-centered team approach which supports each resident in the development of his/her potential for greater independence.

## MENTAL HEALTH

### Outpatient

Provides a continuum of comprehensive services for children and families, including assessment; individual, family and group therapy; case management; psychiatric services; parenting groups; in-home counseling; school-based mental health counseling; neuropsychological testing. Programs include: REACH, Full Service Partnership, Wraparound, Partnerships for Families, and Prevention and Aftercare.

### Lumina Counseling

Offers individual, group, couples and family therapy, in addition to psycho-educational evaluations & diagnostic assessments for children, adolescents, adults, families & couples.

### The Help Group Center for Autism Spectrum Disorder

Features multidisciplinary assessment, consultation, intervention, family support groups, as well as seminars for parents and professionals.

## LGBTQ+ SERVICES

### Kaleidoscope

Supports LGBTQ+ children, youth, young adults and their families in building healthy relationships, strong social connections and critically needed life skills through its high quality, evidence-based programs.

## VOCATIONAL

### Vocational

Assists adolescents and young adults with social-emotional and/or mental health challenges with the special guidance, skills, support, and work experiences needed to obtain and maintain successful employment. Programs include: The Community Employment Program, Momentum Vocational Services, Silverlining Resale Boutique & Training Center, Student Services, Transition Age Youth Supported Employment, We Can Work, and WorkAbility.

## LIFE COACHING

### Advance LA

Addressing the question, "What happens next?" Advance LA provides teens and young adults with special needs and their families support in the transition to adulthood, including one-on-one life skills, social events, workshops and conferences.

## RECREATIONAL & SOCIAL SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

### Kids Like Me

Provides after-school enrichment, social skills groups and day camps designed specifically for children and adolescents with ASD and other developmental challenges.

### Paws & Pals Animal Assisted Intervention

A volunteer-supported pet intervention program designed to engage young people with social and communication challenges.
